

FEDERICA DE PASCALE IS THE NEW PRESIDENT OF THE YOUNG ENTREPRENEURS OF ASSOCALZATURIFICI

Taking over from Elisa Lanciotti, she will remain in office for the three-year period 2023-2026

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Federica De Pascale is the new President of the Young Entrepreneurs of Assocalzaturifici, the national association representing industrial shoemakers in Italy.

Born in 1999, she takes over from Elisa Lanciotti and will remain in office for the three-year period 2023-2026. Currently enrolled in the Economics and Business School of the University of Naples Federico II, De Pascale has followed in her family's footsteps and works at Calpierre, the business her grandfather Ciro De Pascale founded in the 1960s. Training, inclusion and involvement, transversality with the different trade associations are the assets the programme of the newly elected president is based on.

Alongside the new President will be four vice-presidents: Eleonora De Lucia of Calzaturificio Marciano (CE), Gianluca Tomat of Lotto Sport Italia (TV), Matteo Piervincenzi of Calzaturificio LE.PI. (MC) and Thomas Schlecht of Parabiago Collezioni (MI).
